SUBMISSION DETAILS

The Marlborough Arts Center has the right to decline any work that does not meet these criteria. Please adhere to the following:

- Marlborough Arts Center members may enter two pieces; non-members may enter one piece.
- All work must be wired and ready to hang on gallery walls. (No saw tooth hangers.) Please no Photography, Sculpture, Textile, nor Jewelry.
- Overall size (including frame) may not exceed 30” on the longest side.

There is a one-time non-refundable entry fee of \$20 for artwork submitted.

There will be a 20% commission on any sales, with your check available at the end of the show. You may also indicate “NFS”.

ABOUT THE JUROR

Bill Colrus is a longtime illustrator, cartoonist, and graphic designer. A graduate of Paier College of Art he subsequently went on to become an adjunct faculty member, teaching at the college for 33 years; his subjects included Illustration Techniques, Advertising Design, Publication Design, and Color Theory. Now retired, he currently enjoys teaching independent of the college; providing him free reign to implement his own philosophies and perspectives in his teaching. As a fine artist exhibiting throughout the region his work has garnered many awards, including first place, “Best of Shows”.
