IMPORTANT DATES:

- **Drop off Artwork:** Sunday, April 21 from 1 to 4 PM or Monday, April 22 from 4 to 6 PM
- **Opening Reception and Awards:** Sunday, May 5 from 2:00 to 4:00 PM.
- **Pick up Artwork:** Sunday, June 2, from 2:00 – 4:00 PM or Monday, June 3, from 4:00 to 6:00 PM.
- Online viewing of Exhibit will be available at www.marlborougharts.org.

SUBMISSION OF YOUR WORK:

- Artist members may enter up to three pieces of artwork, including paintings, sculpture, pottery, jewelry, fiber art, digital art and wood-turned works, which will be judged for awards.
- All art must be original: no prints.
- All paintings and any works that will hang on the walls must be wired and ready to hang. (No saw tooth hangers, please.)
- Overall size of framed art may not exceed 36" on the longest side (including frame).
- Artists are encouraged to email photos of artwork being submitted. Send to marlboroughartscenter@gmail.com prior to drop off. These will be posted on our website.

ENTRY FORM:

- Entry forms will be available in the Arts Center at drop-off.
- PLEASE DO NOT ATTACH THE ENTRY FORM TO YOUR PAINTING!
- While entry forms will be available for downloading from the website, we encourage you to wait to pick up and complete entry forms until you come in for drop-off of your work.
- If you choose to print the entry form from the website, be sure to select "Fit to one page" under "scaling" when you print it.

FEES:

- \$10 for one piece, \$20 for two pieces, \$25.00 for three pieces.
- Membership dues must be up to date in order to participate.
- New memberships or renewals will be accepted at drop-off of work.

- Payment can be made by cash, check or credit card.

JUDGE: Rebecca J. Moran, a practicing fine artist, professional graphic designer and university professor. She is executive creative director and owner of a small progressive design studio, Spring Hill Studio, LLC located in Northeastern Connecticut, half way between Boston and New York.

Rebecca holds an MFA in Visual Arts from The Art Institute of Boston, a Master of Science in Art Education and a Bachelor of Fine Art in Oil Painting from the University of Connecticut.

GALLERY WILL BE OPEN:

Friday through Sunday every week from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM from May 10 – June 1, 2022, including Memorial Day weekend.

Participating artists are cordially urged to gallery-sit for one afternoon during exhibit hours. A calendar for signing up will be available at drop-off.
