#### IMPORTANT DATES:

- **Drop off Artwork:** Sunday, April 27 from 1:00 – 4:00 PM or Monday, April 28 from 4:00 - 6:00 PM
- **Opening Reception and Awards:** Sunday, May 18 from 2:00 - 4:00 PM.
- **Pick up Artwork:** Sunday, June 8, from 4:00 – 6:00 PM or Monday, June 9, from 4:00 - 6:00 PM.

#### SUBMISSION OF YOUR WORK:

- Artists must be MAC members to enter
- You can join or renew online under [Membership on the website](http://marlborougharts.org/membership/join-today)

- Or you can join or renew your membership when you drop off artwork, **cash or check ONLY**
- Artist members may enter up to three pieces of artwork, including paintings, sculpture, pottery, jewelry, fiber art, photography, digital art and wood-turned works, which will be judged for awards.
- All art must be original: no prints.
- All paintings and any works that will hang on the walls must be wired and ready to hang. **(No saw tooth hangers!!!)**
- Overall size of framed art may not exceed 36" in width or 40" in height (including frame).
- Works that have previously been exhibited in any of the Marlborough Arts Center's Members' Shows are NOT eligible for entry.

#### ENTRY FORM:

- Entry forms will be available in the Arts Center at drop-off.
- Entry forms will also be available to download and print from the website.
- Entry forms include the labels for your artwork. Please do not cut and separate the labels until you have submitted everything to us.

#### FEES:

- \$10 for one piece, \$20 for two pieces, \$25.00 for three pieces, **cash or check ONLY.**

- Membership dues **must be up to date** to participate.
- All payments made during drop-off must be **cash or check ONLY**.

#### JUDGE:

Jack Broderick, a practicing fine artist, paints and teaches from his studio at The Mill Works in Willington, CT. He uses both image and feeling in developing his paintings. To him, painting is a conversation between artist and subject whether the subject is a model, a landscape or a still life. He has traveled and painted extensively in Ireland, Argentina, Spain, Cuba and Italy. He has exhibited internationally in Paris, Tokyo, Buenos Aires, Palermo and Tilcara.
